MONEY SHOOT RULES

1. No Alcohol or Drugs on Club Grounds
2. 6 rd. shoot, Limited to buying 1 rd. Free Food Provided.
3. 4 rd. shoot. Limited to buying 2 rds. Buy Your own Food
4. Red Light on, action open, and step away from gun
5. Judge's decision is Final.
6. If you walk away from table with a judged card, the card is DEAD.
7. If you have a question about your card, ask the judge.

8. Limit your time at the bench before and after you shoot.
9. Shells will be handed out at the bench.
10. All practice shells must be put away prior to shoot starting.
11. Please put spent shells in containers
12. Unsportsmanlike behavior will result in being asked to leave the shoot without a refund.
13. Three shells for two dollars (\$2.00) for Practice
14. At the end of the shoot, boxes can be sold for \$16.00 per box until they are sold out.
15. During practice shooting, please be courteous of those waiting to practice.
16. Practice starts 9:00 am and ends at 11:00 am and shoot will start promptly at 11:00 am.

BLOCK SHOOT RULES

1. All types of sights, including scopes, are acceptable.
2. Only 12 gauge shotguns with a maximum of 36 inch barrel length allowed.
3. All shells will be provided by the **Green Springs Rod and Gun Club**.
4. When your turn is called, you have two calls to be at the window prepared to shoot.
5. A shooter must shoot **five rounds** or pay an additional fee equal to the cost of five rounds to qualify to shoot in the **"MONEY ROUND"**.
6. No signups for the **"MONEY ROUND"** will be permitted once shooting of the **"MONEY ROUND"** has begun.
7. All first place winners from the **'MEAT ROUNDS'** throughout the season, qualify for a free shot in a **"APPRECIATION SHOT ROUND"** at the end of the season's last shoot.
8. **No person under the age of twelve (12) will be permitted to shoot unless they have a parent member or guardian accompany them and to load and unload the gun.**
9. All parents or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children. Please monitor them during the shoot for everyone's safety.
10. **NO** alcohol or controlled substances are permitted on the Club property
11. Any person known to be using alcohol or controlled substances will not be permitted to shoot.
12. All guns will be kept in gun racks when not in use. This is for the safety of all.
13. Barrel must be out of the window before loading or unloading. Never bring the barrel inside while loading or unloading. If any firearm problem occurs, ask for assistance from the shoot monitor.
14. **NO SHOTS ARE TO BE FIRED WHEN THE RED LIGHT IS ON!!!!**
15. When the red light is on, point your gun in the safest possible direction and wait for instructions from the shoot monitor.
16. Closest **"BB"** to the center of the marked **"X"** will be the winner and or closest part of the hole from the **"X"**. (Exception: Shoot for Money Round).

17. All measurements are made using the aid of an optical comparator. (This allows the judge to measure to within .005 of an inch.)

18. All measurements are made from the closest edge of the "BB" to the marked "X" on the card. A perfect "BB" would measure .041 inches, since the typical diameter of a #8 shot is .082 inches.

19. When the round portion of the "BB" is not easily determined, the mark will not be judged. These marks are usually caused by fragments from the shell casing and/or wad. At times a small slit from a "BB" striking the holder will show in the card, this also will not be judged as a good hit on the card.

20. NO TIES WILL BE PERMITTED IN ANY ROUND.

A. When a tie exists in any "Meat Round", the off "X" will be used to determine the winner of the placing in question.

B. If a tie still exists after using the off "X", there will be a shoot-off to determine the winner. ...

21. There will be a ten minute wait after the judge posts the "Best" card. During this time period you may question the judge and request that your card be re-judged. At the end of the ten minute period wait, the actual winner will be posted. No further reconsideration will be allowed after the ten minute wait.

THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL

22. All cards which are awarded prizes will displayed until the end of the shoot. This gives other shooters an opportunity to compare their cards with the winning cards. A ticket will be used to pick up all prizes.

23. The pie boards will be displayed until the end of the shoot, giving people the opportunity to double check the boards.

24. All gun prizes will be picked up from a licensed Firearms Dealer.

BLOCK SHOOTING MATCH AND SAFETY RULES

1. All shooters will participate at their own risk. (Ref: House Rule No. 1
(House Rule no. 1 - All Club members, activity participants, and their guests, while on Club property taking part or not taking part in any Club activity will do so at their own risk. The Club will not be responsible or liable for any accident, injury, property stolen, damaged or lost.)
2. All firearms must be presented on Club property in a safe, good operating condition, unloaded with the action open.
(EXCEPTION: When ready to use on the firing line.)
3. Twelve (12) Gauge guns only up to 36 inch barrel lengths and can use scope, red dots, etc.
4. All ammunition will be supplied by the Club and can be changed at the discretion of the committee members.
(EXCEPTION: Wild Cat Shoots. You may bring your own and no discount because you bring your own.
5. One shot per round. (EXCEPTION: Misfires only.)
6. When your number is called --- respond promptly to the firing line with your action open, after three (3) calls the next shooter will be called.
7. Shooters and Line Officers only on the firing line.
(EXCEPTION: Special shooting events.)
8. Always point the muzzle in a safe direction while on the firing line or simply handling the gun. Never sweep the gun muzzle toward anyone.
9. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot
10. Shooters on the firing line will load only under the watchful eye of the line officer and shoot only when instructed to do so.
11. There will not be any scoping targets by non-shooters.
12. If at anytime a committee member declares your firearm or ammunition unsafe or not qualified, you will without argument, remove it from the match and be refunded that monies left in the match, unless you have with you another qualifying firearm or ammunition.
13. If at anytime a committee member observes that you do not know how to operate your firearm safely and declares you an unsafe participant, you will without argument be disqualified and refunded that monies left in the match.

14. If at anytime a committee member, or anyone else, declares that you are an unfair participant, you will without argument be disqualified, forfeit any and all monies paid, and leave Club property immediately. Members will also come under the Club By-Laws.
15. Winners will be determined by the pellet hole that goes through the target nearest the center cross. (Tears, ricochets, or depressions on target will not be considered.)
16. In case of a tie. (At discretion of the judges) Second cross near the lower right corner of target will determine the winner. (Exception: Shoot off for Money Rounds.)
17. All winning cards will be displayed until the end of the match. All cards must remain in the club house to the end of the match.
18. Prizes awarded at the end of the match.
19. Concerning any and all match procedures and rules. The committee members and match judges decision is FINAL.
20. Prizes not claimed within thirty (30) days are returned to the Club and become Club property.
21. All fish bowls, jars, and wheel tickets must be sold to win prizes. If they are not sold, the remaining tickets will be sold at the next shoot or activity for prizes to be awarded to the winning holder. If you have a holder from an unsold bowl or jar, be sure to register it before leaving the Club so if you win at a later date, we can notify you.;
22. Must be 18 years or older to participate in any and all games of chance.
23. No alcoholic beverages or controlled substances are permitted on Club property.
24. Anyone not adhering to Safety or Block Match Rules will be disqualified and refunded monies left in the match, (EXCEPTION: to Rule 14), and leave Club property immediately. Club members will also come under the Club By-Laws.
25. Participants taking part in any Games of Chance--Concerning a firearm as a prize and not legally being able to own a firearm will be given cash in the amount determined by the Activity Committee.
26. No loaded firearm allowed in Club House by anyone, except police on duty and Wildlife Commission officers giving talks.
